The public (and contestants) are welcome to watch, however do *not* come or go *during* the performances. Judges will be remotely located; any contestant speaking will be disqualified. You'll have five minutes to present your piece. Results will be posted within one hour after the last performance in the category, \$1000 first \$500 second \$250 third. First place performers will give a 25 minute performance in the evening beginning at 7pm in the same order as contested. The rules are off for the evening performance, you can bring the whole band with you if you want and talk to your heart's content. For 25 minutes, anyway.
